

\$0 Drug Copay Program

About the program:

Blue Cross' \$0 Drug Copay Program offers \$0 copay (with deductible waived) for certain drugs used to treat certain chronic conditions. Members do not have to meet a deductible before getting program drugs for \$0.

Drugs in the \$0 Drug Copay Program are regularly recommended to treat asthma, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), coronary heart disease, diabetes, heart failure and other common chronic conditions.

The \$0 Drug Copay Program is available for copay-based pharmacy benefits offered through Blue Cross or HMO Louisiana, Inc. The program is not available for coinsurance-only pharmacy benefits.

To find out if you have an eligible plan, call the Customer Service number on your ID card.
